DSTA PARTNERS BAAINBW TO DRIVE INNOVATION IN SUBMARINE AND UNDERWATER TECHNOLOGIES

Singapore's Defence Science and Technology Agency (DSTA) and Germany's Federal Office of Bundeswehr Equipment, Information Technology and In-Service Support (BAAINBw) have signed a Programme Arrangement (PA) on the sidelines of Euronaval 2024 on 5 November 2024.

Under the PA, DSTA and BAAINBw will explore ways to co-develop and procure nextgeneration(s) of batteries for maritime platforms, as well as facilitate expert dialogues in additive manufacturing for components for submarines, underwater platforms and underwater technologies. The arrangement will also facilitate sharing of expertise in areas including safety management, maintenance management and procedures to achieve cost savings for both organisations.

DSTA's Director Naval Systems, Mr Ong Li Koon said, "We look forward to partnering BAAINBw to deliver cutting-edge solutions through innovation and deepening the technical knowledge and research exchanges in the field of submarines and underwater technologies. Leveraging our combined expertise, we will push the limits of technology to further advance our underwater solutions."

"We are very pleased about the collaboration with Singapore, one of Germany's most important strategic partners in the Indo-Pacific region. Expanding our long-standing cooperation offers us a unique opportunity to implement specific projects in the field of our key technology submarines with an equal partner at eye level.", said Rear Admiral Andreas Czerwinski, Head of the Division Sea of BAAINBw. "The similarities in our submarines U212A and U218SG allow us to mutually benefit from each other's experiences, for example because of the deployment in very different environments."
